#### 3. DRC PRESIDENCY MEETING

On April 29, 2013 the scheduled meeting of the presidency was held. Videoconference facilities were used to talk about the DRC annual conference at the University of Agricultural Sciences and Veterinary Medicine in Cluj Napoca (Romania, November 7-8, 2013). Preliminary agreements of three EU Commissioners (Ciolos /AGRI/, Geoghegan-Quinn (RESEARCH) and Hahn /REGIO/) to participate in the conference already exist as well as the preliminary consent of the top representatives of Romania (incl. Prime Minister). Joint Research Centre (JRC), Danube Academies Conference (DAC) and others will be also represented. The plenary session will consider issues like research and innovation strategies and partnership in Danube region, JRC support to EU Strategy for Danube Region (focus on research and innovations), cooperation of DRC and DAC. The draft of the programme will be circulated at the end of May/beginning of June 2013. The presidency also decided on the DRC bank account to be at Raiffeisenbank in Vienna which will facilitate the administration. The forms of cooperation with JRC and DAC were discussed as well. DAC will be offered to sign a Memorandum of Understanding between DAC and DRC (this memorandum already exist with JRC) or will be offered to use DRC associate membership without voting rights (according to DRC Statute). The forms of cooperation with JRC will be during the high level event in Bratislava (May 16, 2013). At the end of the meeting the participants considered the preparation of theDRC summer schools, DRC video-contest (a flyer will be sent to all member universities) and the Danubius Award.
