News from our Network

DRC Presidency Meeting in Prague

The DRC presidency met in January 2013 at the Czech University of Life Sciences in Prague (CULS): The members discussed the issues related to the change of the DRC Status. Other items concerned the change of the secretariat and setting up permanent secretariat, the next DRC annual conferences, and the new DRC web page. The presidency also discussed the involvement of DRC in JRC initiative aiming at scientific support to Danube strategy, organization of the DRC summer schools and the students video-contest: My university and the Danube region (the rules will be disseminated till the end of March).

New permanent secretariat

The new permanent secretariat is in service. It improves the organizational structure of the DRC and provides you as a member a permanent and personal service contact.

The new secretariat – our services for you

- editing and mailing of DRC newsletters, and other relevant mailings
- membership, invoicing of membership fees
- bank account (from early spring on)
- contact and address management
- website and intranet management (from early spring on)

The secretariat is located at the Institute for the Danube Region and Central Europe (IDM) in Vienna. The Institute is since many years a reliable partner of our network. Bernd Janning is working at IDM and manager of the new secretariat. You find his contact data on the first page of this newsletter. If you have any questions concerning the mentioned services, feel free to contact him.

New legal status of the DRC

Currently the new legal status of the DRC is being implemented. At the General Assembly and by e-mail we informed you about the plans to incorporate as an International Non-Profit Association, a legal entity subject to the Belgian law. We believe that this new structure will support DRC in reaching its goals and look forward to our future actions. The process is still not completed. The new status will become effective presumably in early spring. As a consequence, you will receive the invoice of your membership fee later.

New website & intranet

The presidency decided that in future the DRC website will be maintaned by the permanent secretariat. Data transfer, a new design, and content management system are being prepared in collaboration with CULS in Prague. The new homepage will be launched presumably in spring 2013. The web platform will include a new intranet for DRC members. It will give all members easily access to important documents, and data.

Scientific support to the Danube Region – JRC initiative

During the General Assembly we signed a memorandum of understanding with the Joint Research Centre of the European Commission (JRC). One of the outcomes is the initiative launched by the JRC to support the EU Strategy for the Danube Region. A few weeks ago, you received a a detailed letter with information about this initiative. DRC annual conference 2013

The next DRC annual conference will take place at the University of Agricultural Sciences and Veterinary Medicine in Cluj Napoca (Romania, November 7-8, 2013). Three EU Commissioners (Cioloş /AGRI/, Geoghegan-Quinn (RESEARCH) and Hahn /REGIO/) agreed to participate (depending on their time availability in November). The draft programme and more information will be disseminated in April. The main topic of the conference should be research and innovations in the Danube region.
