- 4. Learning and mobility in the shadow of the war considerations and challenges

2. Danubius Young Scientist Award 2022 - Extended Deadline



We are excited to announce a Call for nominations for **Danubius Young Scientist Award 2022!**

The Austrian Federal Ministry for Education, Science, and Research (BMBFW) and Institute for Danube Region and Central Europe (IDM) will grant the award to 14 young researchers - one from each signatory party of the EU Strategy for the Danube Region - Austria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Germany, Hungary, Moldova, Montenegro, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Romania, and Ukraine.

Since 2011 this prize has been awarded to honour individuals with extraordinary achievements in their scientific activity connected with the Danube region! This award comprises **1.350 Euro** as well as the opportunity to be a part of the organized visit of the facilities in Ispra, Italy, in 2023, made possible by the kind support of the European Commission Joint Research Centre - **JRC**.

Scholars from all fields may be nominated by their **hosting institution** (university, academy of sciences, research organizations). Each institution may nominate up to **five researchers**, who may be a part of the different organizational units (faculties, departments, or research groups). In case of more applications, those candidates proposed by the rectorate or management of the organization will be given

preference.

More information on the selection process, award criteria and the requirements of the document submission are available on this **link**.

An award ceremony is planned for October/November 2022, and more details on this event will be announced timely.

The deadline for application is 15th June 2022.

3. EUA Annual Conference



Together with DRC Vice-President and EUA board member Ivanka Popović and DRC Vice-President Friedrich Faulhammer, Rector of the University of Continuing Education Krems (UWK), the IDM Managing Director and DRC Secretary General Sebastian Schäffer attended the Annual conference of the European University Association (EUA).

From April 28th to 29th, 2022, various expert presentations were given on the general topic "University values: what, why and how?" at the University of Technology and Economics Budapest. Together with the Head of Communications, Faulhammer presented the strategic further development of the UWK as a "best practice" model in the breakout session "Strategic Framework instead of Strategy an institution-wide approach to drive values into reality". The "Spotlight on Ukraine" was particularly impressive, not only because of the effects of the war on educational and research institutions, but also because of the personal involvement of a

professor who had to flee her academic institution for the second time after 2014.

- 1. Scrutinize the contexts and causes of illiberal, respectively fictional democracy
- 2. Develop concepts and strategies for strengthening liberal, respectively functioning democracy and its functioning political communication as well as active citizenship in an inclusive and participatory EU
 - 3. Disseminate the project's findings through awareness-raising activities, events and publications for different target groups on the local, regional, national, international and EU levels.
